Purpose

The meeting will have two primary purposes:

1. To discuss the goals and value of the collection and to create unified messaging around these goals and value.
2. To discuss how to move the consortium and collection forward to meet the goals and enhance the value of the collection

Pre-Roundtable education components

To facilitate the discussion and maximize the time at the Roundtable, there will be 2 30-minute webinars that will also be recorded so attendees can review the material at their leisure. The webinars will cover:

- National e-content efforts including SimplyE, the DPLA Exchange, the work of the Internet Archive in this area, and advocacy efforts.
- A data webinar to share usage trends and other data of value to the Roundtable conversation.

Outputs

- A more unified vision among consortium leadership of the value and goals of the shared collection.
- Ideas for messaging to support this vision.
- Ideas for materials to help support advocacy for the collection within the state.
- Greater awareness of national efforts and the potential relationship of WPLC to these efforts.

Budget

Assuming that we are able to find free space at a library, the only cost would be food. Assuming 40 people, the approximate costs for morning coffee/pastries and lunch would be approximately \$400.
